In May 2011, the 6th Community Theater International Festival will be held at the Autonomus University of Madrid. This is an innovative event that intends to be a meeting point for European experiences that use theater as a tool for social intervention.

- José Moura Soeiro, director of the legislative theater project *Estudantes por empréstimo* from Lisbon and member of the Portuguese Parliament.
- Àngela Segura, coordinator of CaixaEscena, a theater program for Secondary Schools organized by the Fundació la Caixa.
